Dear Valued Students and Prospective Enrollees,

At HnH Beauty Academy, we believe in being fully transparent with our students, families, and community. With that commitment in mind, we are writing to inform you of an important update regarding our accreditation status.

What Has Happened

The National Accrediting Commission of Career Arts and Sciences (**NACCAS**) has placed HnH Beauty Academy on **probationary status** as part of its accreditation review process. We are sharing this information openly and proactively because you deserve to know, and because your educational journey and future are our highest priority.

We want to be clear: this is a formal process, and we are fully cooperating with NACCAS to address all identified concerns and meet the required standards for accreditation.

What NACCAS Probation Means

NACCAS is a national, voluntary accrediting agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education. Probationary status is a formal designation assigned when NACCAS has identified areas where a school must demonstrate improvement or compliance within a defined timeframe. It does not mean a school has been closed, stripped of its license, or deemed unsafe.

HnH Beauty Academy **remains fully licensed and in good standing with the Delaware Board of Cosmetology and Barbering and the Delaware Department of Education**. Our state license — which is the legally required authorization for us to

operate and train students — is entirely separate from NACCAS accreditation and is **not affected** by this status.

How This May Affect Current Students

If you are currently enrolled at HnH Beauty Academy, please know the following:

-  **Your program is not interrupted.** Classes continue as scheduled.
-  **Your training hours remain valid.** All hours you have completed and will complete are recognized by the Delaware Board of Cosmetology and Barbering.
-  **Your ability to sit for the Delaware State Board Licensing Exam is not affected.** Your eligibility to become a licensed nail technician upon program completion remains unchanged.
-  **Your diploma and certificate of completion will be issued** as stated in your enrollment agreement.
-  **Certain federal or state financial aid tied to accreditation** (if applicable to your enrollment) may be affected. If you have concerns about your specific financial aid arrangement, please contact us directly so we can review your situation individually.

The bottom line for current students: Your path to licensure and your career in nail technology is not in jeopardy. We are continuing to provide the same high-quality, hands-on instruction you enrolled for, and we will see you through to graduation and licensure.

How This May Affect Prospective Students

If you are considering enrolling at HnH Beauty Academy, here is what you should know before making your decision:

-  **The school is open and enrolling students.**
-  **Our Delaware state license is active and in good standing.**
-  **Our curriculum, 300-hour program, and graduate outcomes remain the same.** Our graduates continue to sit for and pass the Delaware State Board Exam and enter the workforce prospectfully earn \$34,000+ annually.
-  **NACCAS accreditation is not yet fully granted.** Some forms of federal Title IV financial aid (such as Pell Grants and federal student loans) are only available through fully accredited institutions. If you were planning to fund your education through federal financial aid, please contact us directly to discuss your options — including our in-house financing plans, payment plans, third-party lending, and scholarship resources.
-  **Accreditation status may affect transferability** of credits to other accredited institutions. If you have plans to continue your education elsewhere after completing your program here, we encourage you to research transfer policies at your intended school.

We strongly encourage any prospective student to reach out to us directly with questions so we can give you a full, honest picture of how this status may or may not impact your specific situation.

What We Are Doing About It

HnH Beauty Academy is **actively working to resolve all concerns identified by NACCAS** and to achieve full accreditation. This includes:

- Reviewing and addressing all requirements outlined in our probation notice
- Working with NACCAS to submit documentation and evidence of compliance
- Implementing any operational, administrative, or policy improvements required

We are fully committed to this process. Accreditation matters to us because *you* matter to us. Our goal has always been to give our students access to the best possible education with the widest possible doors open for their futures.
